

**DAY 1 QUESTIONS**

What did people have to do to be baptized by John? Who was John talking about when he said that someone was coming who was more powerful than he was?

**DAY 2 QUESTIONS**

Why do you think God the Father chose the words he did for his son to hear? Hear God's words to Jesus as though he is speaking them to you: "You are my (child), and I love you; I am very pleased with you." How do those words make you feel?

**DAY 3 QUESTIONS**

In the desert, what was Jesus' weapon against the devil's temptations? Why was his weapon powerful? When you have to choose between doing what is right and what is wrong, what weapons has God given you?

**DAY 4 SATURDAY ACTIVITY**

Who do you know that needs to know God loves them? What steps could you and your family take to prepare for sharing Jesus with them? Write down their names and some ideas for ways to reach out to them; pray for them; ask God to bless the ways you show them his love.

**DAY 5 QUESTIONS**

How would you describe the good news Jesus said people had to believe? What does it mean to be a fisher of men?

**DAY 6 QUESTIONS**

Jesus healed many people; he drove out many demons. Had you been there to see what he did, what would you have thought? What would his actions tell you about who he was?

**DAY 7 QUESTIONS**

When no one else would, why did Jesus reach out and touch the man who was unclean? Why do you think the man couldn't help himself, disobeyed Jesus, and spread the news of his healing to everyone?

**DAY 8 QUESTIONS**

Why do you think the four men went to so much trouble bringing their friend to Jesus? How did Jesus know what the teachers of the law were thinking?

**DAY 9 QUESTIONS**

Do you think the demons were afraid of Jesus? How do you know?

**DAY 10 QUESTIONS**

Why would Jesus tell Jairus not to be afraid? What things does that tell us about how Jesus cares for us?

**DAY 11 SATURDAY ACTIVITY**

Use God's Word to encourage you as you follow Jesus. Here are some suggestions of faith-boosting scriptures: Psalm 46:1; Matthew 11:28; Matthew 19:14; John 14:27; and 1 Peter 5:7. What other verses, or even Bible stories, do you know that help you?

**DAY 12 QUESTIONS**

What things were the people of Jesus' hometown thinking when they talked about Jesus? They were not pleased with him at all; what were they missing?

**DAY 13 QUESTIONS**

What does his choosing such an unpopular man like Levi to follow him tell us about Jesus? What examples of following Jesus can we learn from Levi?

**DAY 14 QUESTIONS**

After Jesus calmed the storm, the terrified disciples asked each other, "Who is this?" What do you think they might have said to one another? What would you say if someone asked you who Jesus is?

**DAY 15 QUESTIONS**

What do you think happens to sheep that don't have a shepherd? The Bible tells us that 5,000 men ate what Jesus had provided; thinking of women, wives, and children who would have been there, too, imagine how many really ate that day...and had leftovers!

**DAY 16 QUESTIONS**

After sending the crowd away, why do you think Jesus went off alone to pray; what do you think he might have prayed about? Why might Jesus have waited through the night to go to the frightened disciples and help them?

**DAY 17 QUESTIONS**

Who do others around you think Jesus is? Who do you think Jesus is?

**DAY 18 ACTIVITY**

Many people do without something during Lent. Think about something that you can add or do extra that will not only help you remember the importance of this season, but will help you grow in gratitude for Jesus.

**DAY 19 QUESTIONS**

Why would the disciples have been afraid when they saw Elijah and Moses talking with Jesus? What was the command that God gave the disciples; why do you think this command was important? Is it still?

**DAY 20 QUESTIONS**

Jesus already knew what his disciples were arguing about- why do you think he asked them to tell him? How does someone be a servant of everyone?

**DAY 21 QUESTIONS**

Why do you think Jesus told James and John not to destroy the Samaritan village? What was he teaching them...and us?

**DAY 22 QUESTIONS**

Why did Martha think her job was important? Which person do you feel more like-Martha or Mary?

**DAY 23 QUESTIONS**

Why would Jesus ask the woman, bent over and unable to stand up straight, to come to him (and he not go to her)? Why do you think the synagogue leader was really angry?
